Items of business and discussions

P3WG Update

Chris Boleman is currently working with Lisa and others to develop a survey instrument. The purpose of the instrument is to develop action plan to narrow focus. The instrument will assess the priority needs of curriculum. The purpose is to not remove current curriculum but to prioritize the needs. The team hopes to have results for everyone in March. Chris will provide more information later as the project progresses

Southern Region Volunteer Committee

Charles Cox requested more information. Inquired about volunteer specialists wanting to create a volunteer advisory board. Arch Smith reported approximately 180 participants. He has not seen the evaluation summary. Arch also stated the plan is to continue hosting the meeting and the University of Georgia would absorb financial loss if any. Georgina, North Carolina, and Kentucky are taking leadership for the advisory committee. Noah Washburn commented on hosting a regional meeting in the western part of the region and including neighboring states. Monsanto funding was questioned. Charlene Jacob stated evaluations had been collected. A project was developed and will be implemented back in the states. The advisory committee is assembling a volunteer notebook. Cathy recently hired a volunteer specialists and the advisory committee made contact. It was also stated, there is no funding for a state symposium.

National 4-H Conference

Rukeia stated there was intent to contact 1890 institutions to ensure attendance of youth and college students. Another individual stated applications for facilitators and leadership team are located on the conference website. Youth wanting to be a part of the leadership team must have attended National Conference before. Facilitators are college level individuals and no experience with National Conference is needed.

Biennial Conference

Boyd Owen stated the conference will be held March 3-6 in downtown Charleston. The Mariott hotel has been selected. The call for proposals has been distributed. The cost for registration will be \$300.00 and the hotel will be \$142.00 per night. Registration will be collected through an online process.
