Bobby introduced John McGee, Geospatial Extension Specialist with VT. John gave a presentation on the Nation Extension Web-mapping Tool (NEWT). NEWT is a cloud based nation-wide dataset consisting of digital maps that can be used to query more effectively use spatial data for decisions regarding programming and strategic planning. It relies on maps and census data to provide Extension administrators and staff with nation, state, and county level with spatial data. Shane Bradt (UNH) and John McGee are hosting a Webinar through eXtension on the National Extension Webmapping Tool (NEWT) on Thursday, February 22 at 2PM.
