III. Old Business (Plan of Work):

- <u>Social Media Guidelines</u>: Matt compiled social media guidelines from institutions and sent them to Rachel Wellborn (SRPLN Executive Committee ex-officio member) and Communications (COM) Committee members on September 9, 2014. - White Paper on Communication Skills in Extension Education: For this three-part effort, Ruth has completed a literature review. Suzanne did a follow-up with PSD Chair Laura Downey to explore the group's interest in collaborating to assess and develop Extension professionals' communications skills. Maria oversaw a survey to identify current communications training for Extension educators at land-grant universities in the Southern region. The document was e-mailed to COM Committee members on April 15, 2015 for comments. Final revisions are being made and the white paper will be posted to the PLN website and submitted to *Journal of Extension* and *Journal of Advanced Composition* for consideration.
