How Institution is Addressing the Situation:

Top 3 Program Highlights of Current Year: (program, collaborators, impacts)

- EFNEP Program has been restructured and hired three new program paraprofessionals. Between the two adult programs they have graduated 65 participants from the Centi\$ble Nutrition Class.
- WVSU acquired a sub-award from University of Georgia to implement information about the Affordable Care Act. More than 50 individuals were enrolled through the program with over 300 receiving educational activities relating to the topic.
- The VITA program processed income tax returns with a total of \$42,398.00 in refunds awarded. 34 WV residents earning less than \$58,000 household income were provided free income tax filing services giving them the opportunity to remain in good standing with the government by filing their taxes. This program also increased knowledge in financial literacy by providing recipients with information on earned income tax credit, child tax credit, deductions, and smart ways to save/spend refunds, which can improve the overall economic state of WV.
