- 1. February minutes were approved as presented
- 2. Update from AEA L. Washington Lyons, Mark Latimore, Carolyn Williams
 - House Appropriations Committee completed its mockup of the 2017 Ag budget.
 - i. AFRI is the only program that received an increase with an additional 25 million in funding.
 - ii. eXtension was restored to the 1.5M line
 - iii. All other programs were approved at 2016 levels
 - Senate has not marked up its bill yet. That may be done possibly next week or first week of May. Senate may be more favorable.
 - Central State University has employed an Associate Director for Extension, Clarence Bunch, a 26 year employee with NRCS
 - A book scholarship has been set up in memory of James Hill, former limited resource coordinator for SSARE at Ft. Valley State. Donations can be made through the Ft. Valley State website
 - AEA's summer meeting will be in Oklahoma City, hosted by Langston University, June 20-23, focusing on innovation in Extension.
- 3. Update from ASRED Ron Brown
 - May 1 is the deadline for nominations for the Diversity and Excellence in Extension awards.
 - Work on 2018 Farm Bill is beginning with discussion on what may be needed to support Extension. Extension Directors and Administrators will have input at the September NEDA meeting.



- NIFA is doing a study on capacity funds. There will be an opportunity for Directors and Administrators to provide input as well as other stakeholders. This may be a good opportunity to show the value of capacity funds and use the information for budget support.
- 4H marketing campaign is underway. Most of the south is participating.
- Chuck Hibberd is leading a task force looking at how Cooperative Extension can best work as a system.
